The Africa Academy of Management (**AFAM**) would like to announce a continuation of the Africa Faculty Development Workshops (AFDW) that were held in conjunction with the Academy of Management (**AOM**) in Kigali, Rwanda and Accra, Ghana. The next workshop will be hosted by The American University in Cairo (Cairo, Egypt) from **9 to 13 June 2019**. Applications for this workshop are welcomed through **1 February 2019**.

The **Africa Faculty Development Workshops** are a series of programs aimed at promoting excellent PhD and new faculty research, assisting with the advancement of research scholarship, and helping to develop the next generation of Africa's academic leaders. The first two workshops sponsored and funded by the Academy of Management were held in Accra, Ghana in 2011; and Kigali, Rwanda in 2012. The third workshop was held in Pretoria, South Africa in 2015, with sponsorship from the University of Pretoria, while the fourth workshop took place in Kumasi, Ghana in 2017, with sponsorship from the Ecowas Bank for Investment and Development (EBID).
